2012-2013 Make-Up Plan for

School Days Missed Due to Inclement Weather

After five (5) or more days are missed, Saturday (during the week we miss a day) may be used as a make-up day. No more than two (2) Saturdays in a four (4) week period and no more than two (2) consecutive Saturdays will be used to make up days missed due to inclement weather.

There must be a mandatory workday at the end of the year. As these make-up days are used, teachers and staff should keep this in mind. The following days will be used in this order for making up missed days during the 2012-2013 school year:

5. May 28 (After this 5th day is missed, Saturday make-up days begin. Therefore, the following make-up dates may be altered):

7. May 30
8. May 31
9. June 3
10. June 4
11. June 5

15. June 11
16. June 12
17. April 5
18. April 4
19. April 3
20. April 2
21. April 1

*Reminder: After the last student day, a Mandatory Workday will be added for teachers and administrators.

- Please note that the Superintendent has the discretion to make necessary changes to the make-up plan for various circumstances. Such changes may impact not only the order of days used, but the last day of school for students and teachers.
